Purpose

There existed a double Middle Ages. In the twelfth century an era began with a variety of names: Renaissance of the twelfth century, twelfth-century crisis or revolution. Its spirit continued for many centuries and left profound marks on European society. Legal learning was reborn. It developed and interpreted the new circumstances of the cities with their expanded jurisdictions outside the city. The new circumstances in the villages and hamlets of the countryside created challenges for the old lordships. They were forced to interpret this new age and to defend their interests with force but, at the same time, were attracted by new opportunities to

exercise their power. The old lordships managed to re-establish their original power at times in the cities through various institutions and evolving relationships they had developed in the cities. In this new age the jurists attempted to manage the new social and economic life of the cities and the countryside with their knowledge that emerges after the Schism of 1054.
